

Student Preparation



Communicating with the students is just as important as finding them. Set up a meeting with them as soon as they have been identified.

Many students do not know what to expect. They may not know what Rotary is or why they were selected for participation in the conference. It is up to you as the coordinator for the club to answer all their questions.

Students should understand what is expected from them. They should be invited to a club meeting prior to their attendance at the conference, students should also be expected to come back to the club and do a program. It is preferable to do this as soon after the conference as possible. Most students will come home energized and more than willing to make a presentation to the club. This is a program the members of your club are sure to enjoy!

Perhaps the most important task you have is that of determining how transportation will be arranged. The trip to Lamar, Colorado, could be several hours depending on your location. It is very unfair to the students to expect them to make all the arrangements for travel without some communication with the club. Many clubs transport the students. This can often be a rewarding experience. This travel time is a perfect opportunity to meet these young people and learn about their interests and talents.

In any case, please do not make the mistake of just finding a student and stopping the process at that point. Communication is one of the major topics of the conference and should also be important to the club and the students.
